The results are in! We had 299 families participate in the **Board of Education Communication Survey** during the month of September. Here are some of the highlights:

Parents prefer to receive all emergency information by phone and some would prefer to receive all communication by phone;

Parents prefer to receive weekly academic information in a Friday Folder. Receiving an e-mail message from the teacher came in a close second.;

Parents welcome a more frequent and electronic version of the Horizon. The most important things they want to see in the Horizon include a Calendar of Events, Student Activity information, and curriculum information;

Parents welcome a monthly electronic version of the school newsletters.
